# PIKE GRIDDERS

WITH THE FIRST QUARTER COMING TO A CLOSE, PIKA CONTINUES TO IMPRESS PEOPLE ESPECIALLY IN ATHLETICS. THE FOOTBALL TEAM IS UNDEFEATED AND HAS CAPTURED THEIR LEAGUE CROWN. VICTORIES CAME OVER KAPPA SIGMA 3-2 ON A CHRIS BURGER 20 YARD FIELD GOAL, WITH ONLY 14 SECONDS REMAINING; ACACIA 9-3 ON A 6 YARD TOUCHDOWN PASS TO TERRY RAULIN FROM WARREN "BELLY" ROGERS, AND A SAFETY BY RUSHER ROG HARPER; BETA THETA PI 0-0 IN SUDDEN DEATH. 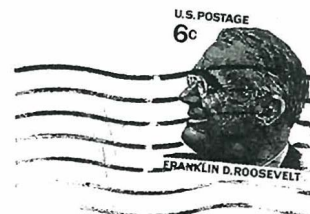
